

Eclipse Summit Europe 2010 Conference Exhibitor Rules & Regulations

1. **Show Management** – The words “Show Management” as used here means the Eclipse Foundation or its committees, agents or employees acting for them in the management of the show.
2. **Eligible Exhibits** – Show Management reserves the right to determine the eligibility and compatibility of any company, product or services for inclusion in the show.
3. **Installation/Show Hours/Dismantling** – Hours and dates for installation, showing and dismantling shall be as specified by Show Management. Show Management reserves the right to alter show hours in any manner in the best interest of all exhibitors. Exhibitors are liable for all storage and handling charges before opening of show or by conclusion of dismantling period.
4. **Defacing of Property** – Nothing can be attached or fastened to the conference center walls, floors or columns. Exhibitors are liable for any damage caused by themselves to display equipment, to the building or in any other manner..
5. **Decorator** – Show Management shall have full discretion and authority in the placing, arrangement and appearance of all items to be displayed by exhibitors.
6. **Display Boundaries** – All exhibit content must be displayed within confines of the exhibit area provided and may not overlap into aisle or neighbor’s exhibit area.
7. **Soliciting/Samples/Animals** – Exhibitors shall not solicit business in aisles or pedestals other than their own. Violators are subject to expulsion. Exhibitor’s representatives wearing distinctive costumes or uniforms, or carrying banners/signs, shall not appear at the show other than at their own exhibit space. Samples, catalogs, pamphlets, souvenirs, etc. may be distributed by exhibitors only from within their exhibit. No food or beverages are allowed on the show floor. Exhibitors may not distribute stickers or decals. Animals are not permitted, unless they support handicapped individuals.
8. **Audio/Visual/Photography** – No music (recorded or live) may be presented by exhibitors at the show. No photocopy or video reproduction is permitted without the consent of Show Management of the subject of the reproduction. Show Management reserves the right to confiscate any film or digital files used in violation of these regulations.
9. **Signs/Illumination** – Should the wording or visuals on any sign in an exhibitor’s display area be deemed objectionable by Show Management, the exhibitor shall make such changes as requested by Show Management. Signage and graphics are limited to the pin board. No floor signs are allowed
10. **Default in Occupancy/Cancellation** – Any exhibitor failing to occupy space contracted for is not relieved of the obligation of paying full rental for such space as provided in the signed contract. If not occupied within two hours of show opening on the first day, such space may be possessed by Show Management for purposes as it sees fit, in which case exhibitor shall still pay full rental
11. **Exhibitor Representatives/Conduct** – Exhibitor representatives shall be restricted to owners or employees of exhibiting companies. Exhibitor representatives shall wear proper badge identification at all times in the show. Show Management reserves the right to expel any exhibitor personnel who are conducting themselves in a discourteous or improper manner in the opinion of Show Management. Exhibitor shall attach no liability to Show Management should their personnel be expelled for improper conduct.
12. **Attendance** – Show Management shall have exclusive control over all admission policies at all times.
13. **Re-Location of Exhibits** – Show Management reserves the right to alter locations or exhibitors and change the floor plan if deemed advisable in the best interest of the show.
14. **Sub-Leasing/Sharing Pedestals** – Exhibitors may not sublet their space, not any part thereof, nor exhibit, give as a premium or advertise products/services not offered in their own name, except where such products/services are required for the proper demonstration of exhibitor’s display. Exhibitors may not permit representatives from non-exhibiting firms to work in their pedestals.
15. **Rejected Displays** – Exhibitor agrees that his exhibit shall be admitted and shall remain from day to day solely on strict compliance with the Rules & Regulations. Show Management reserves the right to reject or prohibit any exhibit in whole or part, or any exhibitor or his representatives with or without giving cause. If cause is not given, liability shall not exceed the return to the exhibitor of the amount of rental unearned at the time of rejection. If an exhibit or exhibitor is ejected for violation of these Rules & Regulations, or for any other stated reason, no return of rental fee shall be made.
16. **Exhibitor Representatives Responsibility** – Exhibitor agrees to indemnify the Eclipse Foundation, and the Forum am Schlosspark against and hold harmless for any claims arising from willful or negligent acts of exhibitors, its agents or employees.
17. **Amendment to Rules** – Any and all matters not specifically covered by these Rules & Regulations shall be subject solely to the decision of Show Management. These Rules & Regulations may be amended at any time by Show Management, and all amendments so made shall be binding on exhibitors equally with the foregoing Rules & Regulations.
18. **Agreement to Rules** – By participating in ESE 2010, each exhibitor, for himself and his employees, agrees to abide by the foregoing Rules & Regulations and by any amendments or additions that may be established by Show Management.
